About Refilwe

The lives of Dr. Albert Schweitzer and Mother Theresa and their work with poor people inspired Jean Stewart as a little girl. Jean felt called to serve the poor after she became a follower of Jesus Christ and the inspiration was put into action in 1991, when Jean looked for a site in Randburg to open a clinic for the poor and needy. Her friend and co-founder, Yvonne Jaques, told her about a one hectare site in Drummond south of Lanseria Airport which they consequently rented from the Methodist Church.

From 1991 to 2005 they established a primary health care clinic which incorporated home based care and Tuberculosis management programs, a hospice, a school and a shelter for abandoned children. This was done with the help of numerous volunteers and donors. The site became too small for all the activities and the project site moved to the present project area north of Lanseria Airport during 2005. Jean and Yvonne retired as project leaders when the relocation took place, Jaco van Schalkwyk became project leader and Blue Cross Health took over the health care activities.

Refilwe's Wish list and Project List

HANDS OF HOPE SCHOOL

- Qualified teachers who could commit to teach part-time on a voluntary basis
- Support in running costs for the school
- Support school fees for a child which currently works out at R1700/child/month
- Textbooks, copy books, stationary and art supplies

DAY CARE CENTRE

Nutritious meals – rice and other grains, breakfast cereals, oats, milk powder, fresh fruits

- and vegetables, cheese, bread, chicken, mince meat and sausages, bean and lentils
- Daily expenses per child per month that is currently R630/child
- For the babies: gloves for cleaning bums, bum ointment, towels, face cloths
- Cleaning materials: laundry soap, JIK, Domestos, dishwashing liquid, Handy Andy

- Sponsor training / short courses for the day care workers

- A reliable little car that is low running on petrol for the program manager
